Dear Ms. Wilderotter,

As members of the Connecticut Legislature, we are concerned about the future of telecommunications services in our state. We want to be sure that AT&T's sale of its wireline network to your company will not adversely affect the quality of service provided to Connecticut's residents or diminish the number of telecommunications jobs in our state.

To that end, we write to urge you to clarify your expectations and commitments to the residents of our state by doing the following:

- make an enforceable commitment to continue to build out the U-verse network, especially in underserved, eastern and northwestern parts of the state;
- help us be certain that the sale will not saddle Frontier with so much debt that it will not have the resources to maintain and upgrade the telecommunications network at the highest possible level;
- commit to bringing back into the state as many customer service jobs as possible,
- ensure that customer service support for U-verse will be staffed by Connecticut workers; and
- ensure that Frontier maintains an adequate, trained, Connecticut-based workforce to properly maintain and service the network.

At a time of rapid transition in the telecommunications industry, and, in particular, with a growing recognition of the absolute necessity of access to advanced high-speed broadband networks, we want to be certain the sale of the network to your company truly works for the people of Connecticut.
